Fifth International scientific-practical conference «Simulation and Complex Modelling of Marine Equipment and Maritime Transportation Systems» (SCM MEMTS-2019)

On July 10, the Fifth international scientific-practical conference «Simulation and Complex Modelling of Marine Equipment and Maritime Transportation Systems» (SCM MEMTS-2019) was held in St. Petersburg (LenExpo exhibition complex, pavilion 7, conference hall 7.2). The conference was organised within the framework of the International Maritime Defence Show (IMDS 2019) and was an official event of the Show.

The conference was set up by the JSC «Shipbuilding & Shiprepair Technology Center», St.-Petersburg Institute for Informatics and Automation of the Russian Academy of Sciences, and Noncommercial Partnership «National Simulation Society». Latvian Simulation Society (LSS) acted as an international co-organiser of the conference.

Financial support for the conference was provided by the Committee for Industrial Policy and Innovations of the Government of St. Petersburg.

Information support for the conference was provided by Noncommercial Partnership «National Simulation Society», JSC «Shipbuilding & Shiprepair Technology Center» and St.-Petersburg Institute for Informatics and Automation of the Russian Academy of Sciences.

Themes of the conference had a focus on the following areas of maritime matters and activities:

- designing, building and operation of courts and the sea technics;
- shiprepairing & marine equipment updating;
- designing, manufacturing and operation of means of equipment and arms of sea technics;
  - fleet supply and service, logistics infrastructure;
  - sea transport systems, a sea cargo transportation, logistics;
  - arctic shelf development;
  - ship-building and ship-repair manufactures, port economy.

Authors of papers and the audience of the conference represented 53 organisations, enterprises, companies, and higher educational institutions from Russia, Latvia and Ukraine. A collection of conference papers was published prior to the opening of the conference.

The conference program included 20 panel papers and 17 at-booth presentations.
