



System dynamics education in Russia


- **Natalia Lychkina**, currently co-President of the Russian Chapter of the System Dynamics Society, is actively promoting system dynamics by teaching SD modules in the State Management University (Moscow) in Master Programs. Among her students are businessmen and government officials who study decision-making and management.
- **Dmitry Katalevsky**, co-President of the Russian Chapter of System Dynamics together with his colleagues **Prof. Dmitry Kavtaradze** and **Vladimir Solodov** are teaching system dynamics and simulation games electives in the Lomonosov Moscow State University (School of Public Administration). They target both bachelor and master program students with a breakthrough course combining system dynamics, agent-based modeling and organizational network analysis techniques.
- **Bairam Annakov** is teaching elective course on the Department of Economics of the Moscow State University and High School of Economics.

The Lomonosov Moscow State University and the State Management University are emerging as "knowledge clusters" of the system dynamics field in Russia.

• **Valery Skribans** is actively using system dynamics in Riga Technical University. He has recently finished Latvian national research project "Possibilities to increase efficiency of building industry enterprises" (2009). As a result a scientific monograph was published.

Workshops, conferences and modeling events

- **Natalia Lychkina** conducted a number of worshops in the leading Russian Universities including GUU, HSE, Lomonosov MSU, private training organization IT-Academy and others. Some of the workshops were conducted together with XJ Technologies company and Andrei Borschev.
- **Dmitry Kavtaradze** and Simulation team in the Moscow State University (Dmitry Katalevsky, Vladimir Solodov) conducted a number of workshops including Summer and Winter Schools of Simulation Games (June & December 2009 respectively), Simulation modeling conference in May 2009 at the School of Public Administration and a number of others.
- **Bayram Annakov** through **Empatika** is periodically conducting workshops on project management using system dynamics methodology.
